



Internship Description:

During the period of his/her stay at the university, he/she student will participate in varied activities such as: classes in the Mathematics teacher training course and in Master's disciplines in Mathematics Education (to know more, see www.pppedmat.ufop.br) taught by me and, eventually, by other teachers, if it is of interest to the student; extension actions at the university itself or in schools region; meetings in the research group about the professional development of teachers who teach math; at area events, etc.

Level of Study: Undergraduate or Master's student

Term/Period of the Studies: In the middle or in the final years of the program

Prior Experience Required: The candidate must be able to read and interpret texts in Spanish and Portuguese.

Language Required for the Internship: Spanish

Length of the internship: 2 to 6 months

Internship availability: From August to December 2025

Students must choose the vacancy they wish to apply for from the **catalog** and complete the **application form**. You must have the following documents on hand:

- Transcript of Records;
- Certificate/declaration of enrollment from home university;
- Letter of Motivation;
- Copy of the passport (necessary for the Acceptance Letter).

Deadlines:

- October 31st, 2024: internship between February and July, 2025
- April 30th, 2025: internship between July and December, 2025

- b) A copy of your flight ticket;
- c) A copy of your health insurance certificate;
- d) A copy of your student visa – see *topic number 3 for more information*

2. Cadastro de Pessoa Física (CPF)

CPF is a Brazilian individual taxpayer registry identification – a registration in the Brazilian Treasury Department (Receita Federal). A CPF number is a mandatory document for your enrollment at UFOP.




3. Student VISA

In order to be able to enter Brazil's national territory, you must get a *Temporary Student Visa IV (VITEM-IV)*, mandatory for foreigners pursuing undergraduate or graduate academic studies in Brazil. Brazilian visas must be requested at the closest Brazilian Consulate (<https://www.gov.br/mre/pt-br/consulado-paris/servicos-consulares/visas>).



What were or have been the BEST aspects about your experice in Brazil so far?



What were or have been the WORST aspects about your experience in Brazil so far?



Have you suffered, during your stay in Ouro Preto, Mariana or João Monlevade, any kind of violence (being robbed, assaulted, etc)?




Experience in Brazil

Has your previous general view about Brazil changed after your experience in the country?


